ORDER GRANTING SPECIAL DEPUTY RECEIVER’S APPLICATION TO REQUIRE ELECTRONIC SERVICE OF PLEADINGS AND NOTICES

The Court considered the SDR’s Application to Require Electronic Service of Pleadings and Notices (the “Application”). Having considered the Application, the Court finds as follows:

1. The *Order of Reference to Master* (“Order of Reference”) entered by this Court on March 15, 2013 provides that applications filed pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 443.007 are referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding;
2. The Application was submitted to the Special Master in accordance with the Order of Reference;
3. Notice of the Application was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE §443.007 (d) and the Order of Reference, and no objections to the Application were filed;
4. The Special Master has issued a recommendation that the Application should be granted pursuant to Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure;
5. The Court has jurisdiction over the Application and the parties affected hereunder; and
6. The Application should be GRANTED in all respects.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Application is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the SDR and all other

parties at interest, parties requesting notice and all other individuals and entities shall file any pleading, plea, motion, applications, notices and all other matters requiring service in this proceeding by email;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the SDR shall, by its counsel, Christopher Fuller, whose email address is *cfuller@fullerlaw.org*, create and maintain a current list of email addresses of all parties and provide the list and a copy of this Order to all parties in interest and parties requesting notice;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all parties at interest and parties requesting notice shall provide to the SDR's counsel its email address; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the SDR may, at its discretion, serve any pleading or notice by any other means authorized by TEX. INS. CODE ANN. §443.007, the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure or other order of this Court; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Order constitutes a final order fully resolving all issues relating to the Application, provided that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to issue further orders pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE Chapter 443. This Order does not modify any of the terms or provisions of this Court's *Order Appointing Rehabilitator and Permanent Injunction*, dated March 8, 2013.
