**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO
SUPPLEMENT CLAIMS FILING PROCEDURE**

On this date, the Court heard the *Application to Supplement Claims Filing Procedure* (the "Application") filed by CANTILO & BENNETT, L.L.P., solely in its capacity as Special Deputy Receiver of Santa Fe Auto Insurance Company (the "SDR" and "Santa Fe" respectively), The Special Deputy Receiver appeared by and through its counsel.

Having considered the Application, the Court finds as follows:

1. The *Amended Order of Reference to Master* entered on April 5, 2013 ("Order of Reference") provides that motions filed pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE § 443.007 and § 443.303 are referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding;
2. Notice of the Application was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE §443.007 (d) and § 443.303 (e);
3. The Texas Property and Casualty Insurance Guaranty Association ("TPCIGA") filed its acknowledgement and waiver;
4. No objections to the Application were filed;

5. The Court has jurisdiction over the Application and the parties affected hereunder; and

6. The SDR's Application should be granted in all respects.

7. All capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meaning as used in the Application,

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. The Application is GRANTED;

2. The SDR is authorized to deem as timely and properly filed Unclaimed Property Claims as described in the Application and then adjudicate the claims pursuant to sections 443.253 and 443.258;

3. The SDR is authorized to file No IGA Coverage Claims, as described in the Application, then adjudicate the claims pursuant to sections 443.253 and 443.258;

4. The SDR is authorized to file the E&O Claims as described in the Application;

5. November 4, 2014, is the deadline for the SDR to file, or deem as filed, the categories of claims described herein if the order granting this Application is entered on or before October 5, 2014;

6. If the Order granting this Application is entered after October 5, 2014, the deadline for the SDR to file, or deem as filed, the categories of claims described herein for thirty (30) days after the date recited below for the entry of the Order;

7. All claims filed, or deemed filed, by the SDR under this Order, if allowed, shall be classified having a priority of payment of Class 5;

8. The Court orders that all claimants who assert a third party claim

against a SFAIC policyholder shall not be deemed to have released and waived any claim against the SFAIC policyholder as a result of any POC filed by or deemed filed by the SDR;

9. The Court orders that the POC Order is not modified or supplemented except as expressly requested herein; and

10. This Order constitutes a final judgment fully resolving all issues relating to the Application, provided that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to issue further orders pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE Chapter 443. This Order does not modify any of the terms or provisions of this Court's *Order Appointing Liquidator and Permanent Injunction*, dated April 5, 2013.
